## The HEADS-ED is a screening tool and is not intended to replace clinical judgment.

<u>Scoring</u>: Items can be evaluated independently in terms of need for action. To obtain a total score, add the value of each item together. Referral for a specialized mental health assessment should be considered if the total sum score is  $\geq$  8 and the "Suicidality" item is rated as a 2.
